FCTC/COP8(12)

- 1. COP URGES the Parties:
- (a) to accelerate and strengthen implementation of Article 5.3;
- (b) to remain vigilant towards tobacco industry strategies and tactics to interfere in tobacco control policies;

























FCTC/COP8(16)

- 2. COP INVITES Parties:
- (a) to utilize the MTSF as a guide in setting national priorities and developing programmes and plans;
- (b) to assess implementation of the programmes and plans through the MTSF indicators;

Specific objectives related to WTP:

- 1.1.1. Parties develop, implement and regularly update comprehensive, costed national tobacco control strategies (Article 5): multisectoral and cross-cutting policies, and priority Articles.
- 1.2.1. Share expertise through South–South and Triangular Cooperation.
- 1.2.2 Strengthen the role of knowledge hubs in assisting the Parties.
- 2.2.3 Research relevant to WHO FCTC implementation: Article 20.
- 3.2.5 Monitor policy and programme progress of key WHO FCTC provisions: estimation of lives saved, costs averted and other improved health and economic outcomes.























FCTC/COP8(17)

- 1. COP CALLS ON Parties to consider:
- (a) fully implementation of Article 13 of the WHO FCTC;
- (b) monitoring cross-border TAPS and the depiction of tobacco in the entertainment media;
- (d) assessing current situation on cross-border TAPS and depiction of tobacco in the entertainment media, and their regulatory framework;
- (e) engaging in South–South and Triangular cooperation to share effective measures to address TAPS;
- 2. COP DECIDES:
- (a) to establish an intersessional Working Group: specific guidelines to address cross-border TAPS and depiction of tobacco in the entertainment media.































FCTC/COP8(18)

- 1. COP ENCOURAGES Parties:
- (a) to continuously monitor tobacco industry activities;
- (b) to strengthen awareness-raising efforts about the tobacco industry or related third-party funding, and prevent the use of such institutions' research outputs;
- (e) to seek assistance from the Convention Secretariat's Knowledge Hub for Article 5.3, and utilize the observatories;

FCTC/COP8(20)

- 2. COP CALLS UPON Parties facing complex emergencies:
- (a) to continue doing surveillance for tobacco control;
- (b) to maintain the already existing gains in tobacco control, in:
 - (i) existing tobacco control laws;
 - (ii) infrastructure for tobacco control;
 - (iii) cessation services;
 - (iv) awareness-raising among different population groups;
 - (v) training of the health workforce on tobacco control issues;






























Implementation of Articles 9 and 10: Contents and disclosure

FCTC/COP8(21)

- 4. COP REQUESTS the Convention Secretariat to establish an expert group: reasons for low implementation;
- 6. REQUESTS the Convention Secretariat to explore the feasibility of establishing a global Knowledge Hub;
- 7. ENCOURAGES Parties to acknowledge and implement the WHO Tobacco Laboratory Network methods, and the CS and WHO to support take-up of the WHO Tobacco Laboratory Network resources and capacity-building activities;










Novel and emerging tobacco products

FCTC/COP8(22)

- 5. COP REMINDS Parties:
- (a) to prevent the initiation of these tobacco products;
- (b) to protect people from exposure to their emissions and extend the smoke-free legislation;
- (c) to prevent use of health claims;
- (d) to apply measures regarding TAPS;
- (e) to regulate their contents and the disclosure of the contents;
- 6. INVITES Parties, the Convention Secretariat and WHO to monitor market developments and the use of these tobacco products.
